


RESOLUTION NO. 86-01

- WHEREAS: it is a tradition among the Lakota People to publicly recognize deserving individuals; and
- WHEREAS: William C. Norris and Control Data Corporation have made significant contributions to the quality of life on the Rosebud Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS: William C. Norris has recently retired from Control Data Corporation; now
